Will the falls run dry two years from now? Three new hydro projects propose to divert water from flowing over St. Anthony Falls; Crown Hydro, A. Mill Hydro and Symphony Hydro. One existing facility, Xcel Energy, is planning to ask permission to increase the amount they divert.

Individually, each of these projects warrant close scrutiny. Should all four gain approval, the falls will be effectively shut off for weeks, even months every year. Learn details on each of these projects and hear new policy initiatives from our elected officials.
